Ch 16

Tent in valley of Lemuel: prepare provisions & seeds
Nephi's brothers humble themselves

This is their Exodus

The unmarried family members pair up

10:15 Lehi receives a number of revelations (presumably to prepare them for the journey ahead)
Lehi gets word to go and finds the Lishonah outside the door

- Lishonah: (insights)

- like a smartphone w/ texting & GPS app
- nowhere else in scripture does the prophet find a divinely manufactured artifact? Urim & Thummim?
- what is the second spindle for?
- what did the divine rebuke say?

4 days - Shazer - hunting lodge - twisted

2nd stop → no food → broken & limp bows

fine "steel" → tight/loose translations

murmuting - even Lehi - makes own bow - take what steps we can

rebuke & directions on Lishonah
food & rejoicing

shakes them

Ch. 18

build & finish ship

"driven forth before the wind" - many days

L & L making merry (drinking?)

prompts Nephi to rebuke them

they tie him up

1 Nephi 18:10 poetic description of Lehi & Sariah's
sorrow

~~the~~

Storm, threat of death

this time, no account of their repentance

many days

promised land

pitched tents, planted crops

found animals and metals

Ch. 19

made plates of ore

19:10 the "prophet" Zenos (10-16)

v. 23 i did like all scriptures unto us

1 Nephi 20 - Isaiah 48

waters of Judd - waters of baptism?

The Israelites have not been true to their covenants & must be refined in the furnace of affliction - God will lead them from exile just like he did in the exodus - when they are righteous

1 Nephi 21 - Isaiah 49

v. 1 - special intro for L&L?

Isles of the sea will hear the voice of Jehovah's prophet

He will gather his children from exile

There will hardly be room for their abundance

The former oppressors will serve those who returned

Ch. 22

1-14 summarize words of Isaiah

v. 15 "the prophet" (Zenos?) quoted by Malachi? (Malachi 4:1)

v. 24 "colves of the stall"



v. 28 gives the whole meaning (read)

Ch. 20-22 — ① taught first to L&L and then ~~re~~ engraved years later?
(19:2, 19:22)
