1 Corinthians 1-7

Be Perfectly Joined Together

GT

Many times in ch. 1 Paul refers to the "Lord Jesus Christ" or "Jesus Christ our Lord." The word Lord in greek is kyrios. In the Greek OT, YHWH is also translated kyrios.

Paul wasn't just saying Jesus is the Son of God. He was saying Jesus is God.

Ch. 1 - be unified, because if you compare yourself to others, you rob the crucifixion of its power.

Jews looked for miracles, the Greeks for logic/understanding  
example - friend's word - two sides  
Christ's message is offensive or nonsense,

except to the called, to whom it is power & understanding

\* v.21 God in his wisdom made it impossible for people to know him by means of their own wisdom.

v.27 God chose nonsense & weak.

Search: weakness

Ch. 2 - "secret" knowledge/wisdom of God is only understood by the spirit.

Ch. 3 - God gets the glory for the "accomplishments" we think we achieve  
we are god's plant, we are god's building (tabernacle)

building (oikodomé) the <sup>con-</sup>instruction that prepares us ~~to~~ to be the dwelling-place of God

Shared space between heaven and earth - temple <sup>nos</sup>/hieron

shared space between God and Adam - called of Jesus temple/court

Ch. 4 comparison is not appropriate, the principle of weakness is shown most visibly in the apostles themselves

Ch. 5 you are the bread of God - yeast is sin, Christ is the paschal lamb.
