# 1 Corinthians 8-13 Ye Are the Body of Christ

Ch. 8 → can a faithful saint eat food offered to idols?

- sure, if they aren't worshipping

- unless it causes someone else to question faith

Ch. 9 → Paul is entitled to be paid for his work, but he pays his own way all the same (tentmaker)

v. 20 - lives like a Jew among the Jews (not subject to Law of Moses)

v. 24 - many runners take part in a race

Ch. 10 → don't worship idols

v. 16-17 we are cherishing the body of Christ

we, though many, are one body (continuing ideas from Ch. 1-7)

food offered to idols isn't bad for its own sake; it's the meaning we place on it.

Ch. 11 → covering head, the customs relating to men & women

- women created for men's sake, etc.

- women must cover head

translation clarity → v. 11 neither is the man w/o the woman nor the woman w/o the man  
v. 11 this is our custom

Ch. 12 → spiritual gifts, variety of gifts
