Acts 11:19 Stephen's death scattered many believers out of fear

v. 20-24 → the natural course of events led to increased desire to share

Acts 10 - vision of animals on the sheet

Ephesians 2:11-14

You gentiles were once separated but the walls have been broken down

Numbers 19:15

tied closed - rendering it clean

The idea of "the" prophet is not always present in the Hebrew scriptures - Some examples, Moses, Abraham

Samuel, Elijah, Ezekiel

Acts 11:26

Christians → probably Greek word w/ Latin suffix -anos meaning "servants of" or "belonging to" eg. Augustanos → slaves of Augustus. cf.

Henceforth I call you not servants but friends

John 16:2

whoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service

Acts 10:17 Peter wasn't sure what it meant
