"Continue Ye in My Love"

GT

Jesus washing the feet ← ^{does God choose} how do we get the forms of our priesthood ordinances
- baptism
- ~~see~~ wash of feet

- literally describes himself as the servant (1st. 53)
- what was on their feet?

Remember, John 12:38⁴⁰ tied Isaiah 6 to Isaiah 53. The Lord Jehovah on his throne to the suffering servant who would die & live again. They are both "ram veh nish" or lifted up and exalted. They are also both misunderstood (make the heart of this people fat, so that seeing, they might be made blind) from ch 6 & (who hath believed our report) from ch. 53. So, Christ is both misunderstood, and high & exalted. He is God and a servant.

(ch 12) John spent ch. 12 showing Jesus crowned = Jesus killed

ch. 14. If I don't die, I can't be with you always. 14:3 16:7 - it is expedient

- You think now it's the worst thing that could happen, but it absolutely must happen

(1) The Spirit ^{(4) chief themes} must die to send the spirit. 14:28 - I go away, and come again unto you

(2) Obedience - if you love me ... (Jesus really loves you and you actually need to follow him) 14:16 - I will pray the Father, he shall send you another comforter

(3) Trial & Persecution - you are introducing tension into your life by following me but I'm with you 14:26 the comforter shall teach you

(4) oneness
