feed sick

Father is witness of Jesus - Moses - John the B - works/miracles

John 6

feeding of the 5,000

walking on water

Bread of Life

walk no more with him

Death of John the Baptist

- two birthdays in Bible Pharaoh & Herod

- on both occasions someone in prison was decap.

- History of Herod Antipas & Herodias (niece)

- illustration of "beasts" in government -

on the king's birthday, prisoners die

Daniel 7
Salome was Herod's niece (through Phillip) and grand-niece (through Herodias)

Herod doesn't want to kill John - influenced by wife (v. 20) Mark 6

Pilate doesn't want to kill Jesus

wife tries to tell him

- in both cases, disunity in ruler's household

- When Jesus was condemned he spoke to all his accusers, except Herod

desert place alone

feeding of 5,000

Passover - desert

~~John 6:43 Jews complain because~~

Mark 6

- rejected in Nazareth 2nd time

- 12 sent forth - dust from your feet

v. 11' D&C go on your way rejoicing

2 Ne. 9:34 I shake my garments

- death of John the Baptist

- Herod thinks John has returned to life

- flashback to his killing of John

v. 20 "did many things" = perplexed (torn)

- attempt to withdraw

- feeding of the 5,000

v. 46 mourns

- walking on water

Mark 7

- unwashed hands

v. 6 explicit quote of Isaiah

- replace scripture with words of man

- that which goes in does not defile, but that which comes out

- Phoenician woman's daughter

- healing of deaf and dumb

who so hath ears, let him hear =
listen, then, if you have ears

Walking on water

- Genesaret is halfway between Capernaum & Magdala (5 miles from Bethsaida)

healing in ~~the~~ Bethesda

"The Jews" John 5:10
similar to BoM
rivers of Jews

recall John's structure -

Ch. 1 - prologue - introduce ideas

Ch 2-4 4 Jewish cultural symbols

Ch 5 - 4 Jewish festivals

Bethesda - Sabbath - Jesus does not object
to the Sabbath - He objects to the rules the
Pharisees have put in the Mishnah. The Sabbath
is a perfect day to be made whole
Jesus testifies of his relationship to the Father
judgement to the Son - Daniel 7 (John 5:22)

Bread of life

Manna is bread from heaven - it was God who gave it
— he who believes has eternal life.
You "eat" Jesus when you believe in Him - trusting that Jesus' ^{whole} claims
Jews complain because of the bread John 6:43 [claims]
"murmur"

If you eat of the bread (that is Jesus)
you won't die

The bread is my flesh - adds drink my blood

Jesus is liquid - woman at the well

Turned water into wine - Canz

Jesus' blood - he has turned water into blood
(Jesus' followers have been using wine as sacrament)

Somehow, eating & drinking Jesus' flesh & blood causes
him to abide in us, and we in him
true food & true drink (is it?)

John 1 → God is birthing a new family out
of those who trust & believe

John 7:37-38 if any man thirst, let him come to me
and drink - he that believes will have rivers of living
water will flow from within them

literal trans. - Anyone who thirsts, let him

come and drink, the one who believes in me,
rivers from this belly will flow living water
