Conversion of Lydia, jailer, many more
 City was the site of victory of Mark Antony & Octavian's victory over Brutus & Cassius (assassins of Julius Caesar). They allowed many veteran soldiers to colonize it, & Octavian's bid for the empire was centered there. Other than Rome, it is hard to imagine a more loyalist city to the empire.

Ch 1 Messiah Poem - image of invisible God
 - creator - firstborn among creations, created all powers on earth

- head of the church and author of new creation where we're all reconciled to God
 fullness of father dwells in him

1:19 dwell - katoikēō - to live permanently - to be exactly at home God dwelt in Christ

John 1:14 - eskēnōsen - to encamp, to have one's tabernacle
 Christ dwelt on earth

ch 2:14-15 nailed our promissory note to his cross
 blotting out ordinances against us (Law & sins)
 spoiled principalities & powers, made a show of them
